Climate change and Georgia

Average annual temperature demonstrated only increasing trend during last 50 years - maximum increase in East Georgia (+0.7 0 C) is in Dedoplistskaro, and in West Georgia (+0.6 0 C) in Poti

by 2050, as compared with 1986- 2010, warming will mostly occur in coastal zone and mountainous regions of Ajara (1.6-1.7 0 C), and by 2100 the biggest increase of temperature (+4.2 0 C) is anticipated in Batumi.



Climate change and Georgia

Precipitation increased in most regions of West Georgia, and decreased in East Georgia by 6-8%.

Up to 2050, according to the forecast, sustainable trends of increase of precipitation is anticipated in West Georgia, further their decrease will begin on the whole territory by 10-20% till 2100.



Climate change and Georgia

In Georgia, about 70% of the country is considered to be at risk from **geologic hazards**:

landslides

mudflows

avalanches

flash flooding and flooding
